Chipping Norton is a friendly working Market Town nestling in the rolling countryside of the Cotswolds. It is steeped in history and was once the centre for the Cotswold wool trade. It was given a Royal Charter by King John in 1205.

Centrally located between Oxford, Stratford, Warwick and Cheltenham it offers the ideal location for discovering our beautiful countryside, our rich heritage and just to relax & unwind.

The Crowsnest is a late Georgian apartment with many period features right in the heart of town. Restaurants, supermarkets, a nationally acclaimed theatre, coffee and other shops (many independent boutiques) are a short amble away. Not to mention seven local pubs (some child friendly) all within an easy walk.

Two bedrooms, sleeps 4 and there is, in addition, a double sofa-bed.

We are a non smoking establishment.

The apartment offers spacious accommodation of character, taking in the top two floors of a late Georgian townhouse, giving a commanding view of the bustling market square to the front, and the opportunity of beautiful sunsets to the rear.



The living accommodation and open plan kitchen is substantial with every modern convenience including a full size freezer, full size fridge, dishwasher, microwave, DVD satellite TV, Linn Hi-Fi and free Wi-Fi broadband. The property also offers an open fire as well as full central heating. Even the mobile reception is good (usually).

There are two spacious bedrooms (one double and one twin), an additional double sofa-bed and separate toilet and bathroom (with shower)

Linen, towels and a welcome pack are provided.
